Student scholarship in the NCN SONATA BIS 9 grant ***Combinatorics and Geometry of Matroids and Polytopes***

The Institute of Mathematics of the Polish Academy of Sciences offers a scholarship as part of the NCN SONATA BIS 9 grant „Combinatorics and Geometry of Matroids and Polytopes” led by Dr. Michał Lasoń.

Application deadline: January 21st, 2026 (23:59 CET)

Commencement of scholarship: Starting on February 1st, 2026

Terms of scholarship:

1. The project provides one scholarship.
2. The competition is open to doctoral students and students of Polish universities and scientific institutes, with preference given to doctoral students.
3. The scholarship amount is **4000 PLN per month** for a period of 2 months. In justified cases, with the possibility of extension up to a maximum of 16 months.
4. The rules for awarding scholarships under NCN-funded projects are set out in the Regulations ([annex](#) to NCN Council Resolution No. 25/2019 of 14 March 2019).

Task description:

Future scholarship recipients are expected to be actively involved in scientific and research activities related to the research project “Combinatorics and Geometry of Matroids and Polytopes” including, in particular, active participation in research group meetings. A brief description of the project can be found [here](#).

Meetings with the project manager can take place either in person in Kraków or remotely.

Required documents:

1. CV including academic achievements, awards, and distinctions.
2. Description of academic interests.
3. Contact details (including email) of a person who can be asked to provide a reference for the candidate.
4. Signed [statement](#) on the processing of personal data for recruitment purposes.

The selection of candidates will be made by a selection committee chaired by the project manager. Candidates may be invited for an interview. If there are no suitable candidates, the competition may remain unresolved.
