assistant professor/IM PAN professor/full professor positions
at the Institute of Mathematics
of the Polish Academy of Sciences

Applications must be submitted by **January 30th, 2026**, only using the [application form](#). Open call is open to candidates who obtained their doctoral degree no more than 12 years prior to the application deadline. The application should contain a CV, a research statement, a list of publications and a proposal of the branch and people whom the candidate would like to collaborate with.

By the same date two letters of recommendation should be sent by email to konkurs@impan.pl. In the subject of the e-mail, indicate please “*Open call for 3-7 positions*” and the full name of the candidate.

We encourage to apply all qualified candidates, regardless of sex, racial or ethnic origin, religion or belief, disability, age or sexual orientation.

The successful candidates will be required to conduct intensive research activities in the field of mathematics or its applications. They are expected to establish their own research teams at the Institute of Mathematics (through seminars and care for novice mathematicians) or significantly contribute to the existing teams. The Institute also expects participation in national and international research programs and grants. The achievements of persons employed under this competition will be subject to periodic evaluation.

The open call will be settled in mid-March 2026, and the candidates will be notified of the result by e-mail. The condition of employment is the candidate's consent to be included in the number of persons listed in the application for a statutory grant and to obtain leave from their home institution (if applicable).
