



Doctoral positions in an ERC project

The research group led by **Piotr Achinger** at the Institute of Mathematics of the Polish Academy of Sciences (**IMPAN**) in Warsaw, Poland is seeking highly qualified candidates for up to two four-year PhD positions in the project *Homotopy Theory of Algebraic Varieties and Wild Ramification*, funded by the European Research Council.

About the project: The project is devoted to the study of algebraic varieties and other algebraically defined geometric objects, especially over fields other than the complex numbers.

Requirements: Basic familiarity with algebraic geometry and algebraic topology is required. Good communication skills in English are expected.
